

The Catholic Bible Institute (CBI) is

a three-year program that involves a comprehensive study of the Sacred Scriptures, with particular focus on methods of biblical study, sharing and praying with scripture, and application of skills in Bible-study leadership.

YEAR ONE includes an introduction to the New Testament, with study of the four Gospels, Acts of the Apostles, Pauline Letters, Catholic Epistles, Book of Revelation, Non-canonical Writings, and New Testament Theology.

YEAR TWO includes an overview of the Hebrew Scriptures, with study of the following texts: Pentateuch/Torah, Historical Books, Prophetic Writings, Wisdom Literature, Deutero-canonical Writings, and Hebrew Theology.

YEAR THREE focuses on developing practical skills for working with small groups, with an emphasis on adult learning, facilitation skills, group process, Bible-study resources, and leadership training.

CBI Program Goals:

- To grow in understanding and appreciation of the revealed Word of God
- To learn the basic principles of Catholic interpretation of the Sacred Scriptures
- To integrate Bible-study with Christian prayer and daily living
- To receive training for parish-based Bible study leadership

The CBI will run a total of five semesters from Fall 2013 to Spring 2016. Sessions take place one Saturday each month, from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m., in the Mother Louis Room at the St. Joseph Center, 480 S. Batavia St., Orange, CA.

- May 3, 2014 – NT Theology
